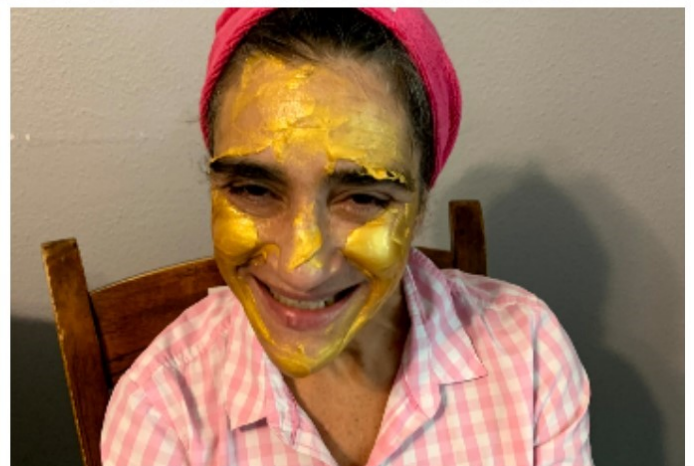

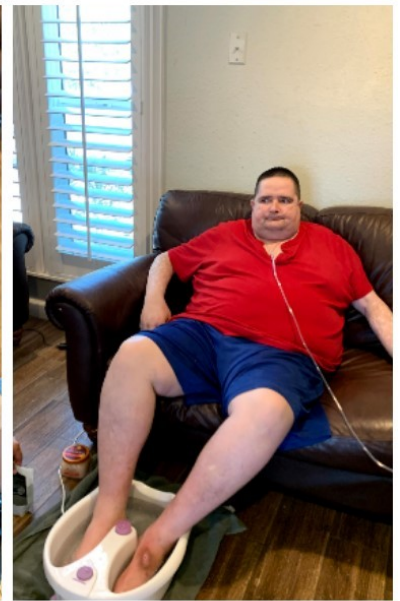

Amelia Earhart Name: _____



Amelia Earhart (July 24, 1897 – June 1937) was an American aviator who broke many world flying records. Earhart was the first woman to fly across the Atlantic as an airplane passenger (1928), the first woman to fly across the Atlantic Ocean (1932) and the first woman to fly from Hawaii to California (1935).

Earhart married George Palmer Putnam (1887-1960), a publisher, in 1931.

Earhart and Fred Noonan (her navigator) disappeared over the Pacific Ocean in June 1937, while on an attempted flight around the world. They had completed two-thirds of their circumnavigation of the Earth. The last radio transmission received from Earhart's plane included, "Gas is running low..." as they searched for Howland Island in the southwestern Pacific Ocean. Neither Earhart, nor the plane have ever been found.

Questions

1. Earhart was the first woman to fly across what ocean?
2. Over what ocean did Earhart disappear?
3. Has Earhart, her navigator or plane ever been found?
